THE PROGRAM

We have delivered the Ready Set Learn Program (RSL) Island-wide since 2001. RSL combines one-on-one summer tutoring with literacy day camps (since 2017) throughout the school-year to support children in grades K-6. The goal of RSL is to help students in English and French maintain or improve their skills in reading, writing and math. We aim to boost confidence and foster a love of learning through fun and engaging activities.

For the past 17 years the program has helped over 11,500 children maintain or improve their literacy skills. The program has employed over 400 post secondary students and has provided them with relevant work experience.

STUDENTS

The Ready Set Learn Program provides free literacy support for English, French Immersion, Francophone and EAL students. Each year resource teachers from all 48 elementary schools across PEI identify more that 1100 students who are struggling in the classroom.

In 2017, we helped 813 students with their reading, writing and math.
We supported 743 students in the summer months and 75 students through our literacy day camps.

OUR STAFF

In 2017, we hired 22 Summer Tutors and 8 Camp Leaders. All of which had enthusiasm, a positive work ethic and a passion for teaching children.

Tutors were responsible for creating individual lesson plans to meet each child's learning needs. Camp Leaders made learning fun for children during literacy day camps. Staff created a positive, comfortable learning atmosphere that promoted personal development and increased confidence.

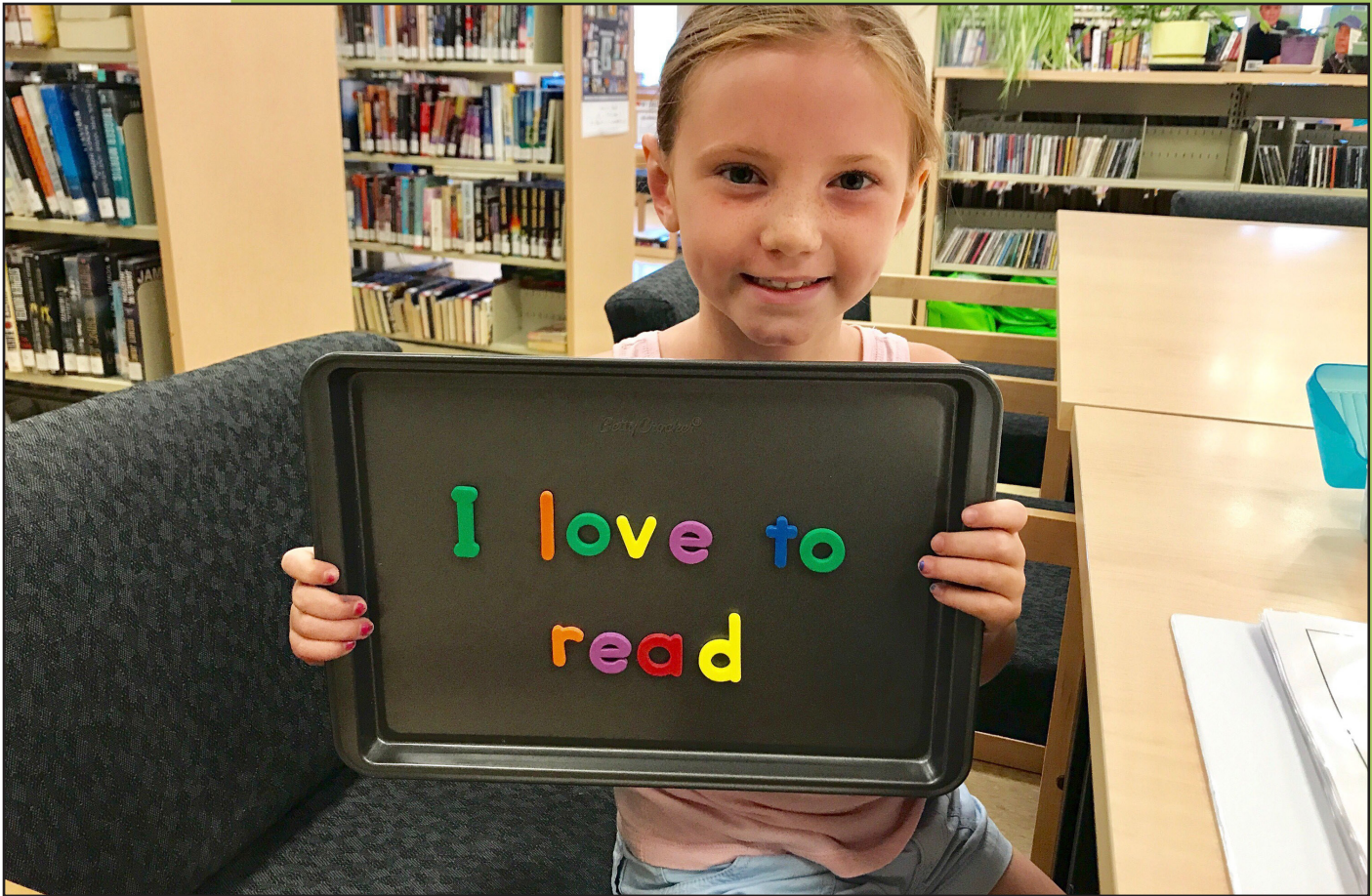
