READY SET LEARN PROGRAM

For the past 19 years, our free summer tutoring program has helped students across PEI with their reading, writing, and math skills.



This free program boosts literacy skills, confidence, and attitude towards learning through one-on-one tutoring sessions at local libraries. This year the Alliance helped 821 students on PEI with their literacy skills. Ninety-two were in Francophone programs, 215 in French Immersion programs, and 515 in English programs.



New this year, the program has expanded into the school year so students across our Island can access free tutoring all year.

STAFF

This year, the PEI Literacy Alliance was excited to have 26 tutors in 27 public libraries across PEI. Each tutor was responsible for maintaining a beneficial relationship with resource teachers, parents, and library staff.

Tutors were tasked with creating individual lesson plans for each student that catered to their individual learning needs. Each tutor came to us with their own vision, creative flare, and attentive demeanour. We couldn't have asked for a better group to help the PEI Literacy Alliance achieve its goals.



SCHOOL-YEAR TUTORING

As a part of the Alliance's efforts to impact the Island, the RSL program is now available during the school year. Tutors worked out of four libraries in Georgetown, Charlottetown, Summerside, and Crapaud with 71 students from 8 schools, including PEIANC. Each student received about 15 hours of tutoring during the year.

Students enjoyed their after school tutoring sessions with one hundred percent of them saying then had fun every time they visited their tutor.

One-hundred percent of parents said they appreciated the free help for their child.
