

Imagination Library Program Report

April 2024 - March 2025

Dolly Parton's Imagination Library is a free book gifting program devoted to inspiring a love of reading in young children around the world. Each month, thousands of children in PEI receive a high quality, age-appropriate book in the mail until their fifth birthday. We have administered this program to families across PEI since October 2020.

Through our program, children can receive up to 60 high-quality books to build their home library free of charge. Research conducted by the University of Nevada shows that as few as 20 books in the home has a positive impact on children's literacy and language development.



Program Benefits

With a focus on early literacy and children's development, our program offers numerous benefits:

- Fosters a love of reading
- Supports literacy skills development
- Strengthens family bonds through shared reading
- Enhances home learning environments
- Supports children's academic and social emotional growth

Evaluation

Our annual evaluations provide us valuable program feedback from parents, guardians, and caregivers. Many of the comments we receive show great appreciation and enthusiasm for our program. Here are some results:

- 99.5% of families enjoy receiving a book each month
- **92%** of families read more
- 79% of children ask to be read to more often
- 85% of adults are more aware of the importance of early literacy
